

Senior Project 2020

In October 2020 the Idaho State Board of Education issued a waiver for senior projects in the 20/21 school year. This waiver enables schools that want to maintain the requirement for the current school year if they choose to do so. Lewiston High School has chosen to have our seniors do a modified version of our Senior Project. Students are still required to complete their senior papers, but will be doing a modified presentation. With concerns over students being in community settings and limited mentoring opportunities because of COVID, the presentation will be focused on the research they completed for their paper.

In addition to our students field experiences being limited, we will not be able to bring in community judges this year to evaluate the presentations.

Because of concerns about the potential of moving into either a yellow or red instructional model our goal is to have all Senior Projects completed before the end of the first semester.

Presentations will be done in students U.S. Government classes on December 8th and 9th

Students are required to have a three slide presentation done on google slides and submitted through google classroom.

1st slide-Title slide (Name and paper title)

2nd slide-Papers thesis

3rd slide-How does your research support your thesis?

Students will have 1-3 minutes for presentations.

If students cannot present on the days set aside for presentations they will need to schedule a time with their government teacher to complete the requirement.

Any student that does not have a 1st semester Government class will need to schedule a time with Mr. Dougherty to give their presentation.
