

Timberlake High School Basketball Game Protocol

Team Protocol for game days:

- Opposing Schools should bring their own basketballs.
- All non-participating players, essential personnel, administrators, and table help are REQUIRED to wear masks.
- Teams will be given a locker room
- Courtside team area (benches) will be spaced to encourage distancing.
- Players and coaches are encouraged to wear a mask on the bench.
- Please make sure that each athlete brings their own water and does not share water with other athletes.
- There will be no hand shake or physical contact made before or after the game with the opposing team or officials.
- Visiting Athletes/Team not in play will be seated behind player benches and must wear a mask.

- Coaches are responsible for ensuring their athletes are following protocol.

Limitations of Gaterings:

- Up to **4** spectators per rostered athlete for both home and away teams into the gym.
 - There will be separate entrances for each school's spectators.
 - Spectators will sign in upon entering the gym.
 - Student Section: Home team only, **50** students allowed. Students must sign up in advance, must have ASB cards, and must wear masks while in attendance.
 - There will be no visiting student section.
 - Up to 6 cheerleaders.
 - Band will be allowed and positioned in the weight room balcony.
- Admission will be charged: Adults \$5.00/Students \$3.00.

Health and Safety Measures

- Spectators
 - Masks and facial coverings are required for all spectators when not seated or physically distanced. For districts and charter school boards that have a mask requirement, this requirement will be in force for

- spectators.
- Masks are highly recommended for spectators.
- For purposes of this plan, physical distancing is 6 feet from non-household members.
- Event areas, such as gyms:
 - Spectators will have to leave the facilities after a JV event, and then the spectators for the Varsity event may enter.
 - Bathrooms will be cleaned and checked multiple times throughout an event. Physical distancing signage will need to be in place in all areas.
- Hand sanitizer should be plentiful and available to spectators and participants.

- **Essential Personnel Away Team:** coaches, managers, book, trainer, admin
- **Essential Personnel Home Team:** Coaches, managers, trainer, admin, clock, announcer, book

Adherence to the athletic guidelines

- Schools will adhere to guidelines and with all Stages of the Stay Healthy Order.

Consequences of Non-compliance

- If a high school is found to be in non-compliance with the athletic guidelines then the following tiered process will be followed:
 - First offense: The school receives a written reprimand from the State Board of Education.
 - Second offense: The school that is found in non-compliance forfeits that event.
 - Third and final offense: The school that is found in non compliance with forfeit all future athletic events for that school sport during the winter season.
 - Schools that choose not to participate in an athletic event at a school that has been found non-compliant will not forfeit the athletic event.
