SCHOOL PROFILE

Lewiston is located at the confluence of the Snake and Clearwater Rivers and is Idaho's only seaport. With access to the Columbia River and beyond, the Port of Lewiston is an important part of the economic diversity of the Lewiston area and the State of Idaho. Already a hub for several industries, the Lewiston area is becoming an increasingly important retirement community and a center for people seeking advanced medical treatment. Lewiston is the Nez Perce County seat. The surrounding agricultural area is also an important part of Lewiston's diversity. Lewiston has a population base of 32,000 and is an area rich in history. Lewiston is also a center for recreation with easy access to many of Idaho's state parks, pristine lakes, whitewater rivers, and majestic mountains. Lewiston enjoys cultural offerings provided by Civic Theater, college and high school theater productions, permanent and traveling collections at art galleries, events at the Center for Arts and History, a multicultural college campus, and materials housed in several museums and interpretive centers.

Independent School District No. 1 received its charter in December of 1880, making it the oldest among Idaho's 114 districts. Lewiston High School is a four-year comprehensive public senior high school with a current co-educational enrollment of approximately 1400 students.
