New LHS/CTE Center Update

The site for the new Lewiston High School and Career Technical Education Center is swarming with activity as the construction phase rolls out. Beniton Construction, the district’s construction management firm, provides the following summary of current work:

- Gymnasium foundation work commenced with the first concrete placement on Monday, July 23, and will continue for the next several weeks.
- Underground plumbing in the gymnasium is underway and the underground electrical has begun.

- Layout and excavation for the auditorium foundations started last week and continue this week.
- Main entrance and part of the bus loop construction started last week and will continue over several weeks.
- General sitework is ongoing with deep utility work anticipated to start within the next couple weeks.
- Contractors are mobilizing and beginning to deliver materials, job trailers, etc.
