

COVID Student Protocols
Independent School District #1 (ISD1)
Lewiston, Idaho
2021 - 2022

Below are the COVID protocols for students for the 2021-2022 school year. Families in the COVID protocol scenarios listed below, will be contacted by Student Services with a timeline for students returning to school.

COVID TESTING PROTOCOL SCENARIOS:

In the event a member of the household has tested for COVID, all students who attend ISD1 schools within the household are required to quarantine until test results have been received. Please contact your student's school to report the absence. When test results are received, please call your student's school with the test results.

- **Negative Test** – Student(s) may return to school, send copy of test results to school.
- **Positive Test** – Student(s) will quarantine for ten (10) days from start of symptoms and may return to school on the 11th day. If no symptoms are present, the ten (10) day quarantine will start from date of testing.

CLOSE CONTACT SCENARIOS:

Scenario 1 (Close Contact): asymptomatic and vaccinated

Student(s) may attend school and is required to wear a face covering for ten (10) days from the date of close contact (i.e., quarantine timeline) and monitor for symptoms. If symptoms develop, contact Dr. Kimberly Eimers, Director of Student Services, for a timeline to return to school.

Scenario 2 (Close Contact): symptomatic and vaccinated

Option 1: May test anytime. Remain in quarantine until test results are returned. If test comes back negative, student(s) may return to school but is required to wear a face covering for remainder of the ten (10) day quarantine. Please send a copy of the test results to school.

Option 2: Quarantine for ten (10) days from onset of symptoms.

Scenario 3 (Close Contact): asymptomatic and unvaccinated

Option 1: May test on or after **5th day of quarantine based on the positive person's quarantine date**. Remain in quarantine until test results are returned. If test comes back negative, student(s) may return to school but is required

to wear a face covering for remainder of the ten (10) day quarantine.
Please send a copy of the test results to school.

Option 2: Quarantine for ten (10) days from onset of symptoms.

Scenario 4: (Close Contact): symptomatic and unvaccinated

Option 1: May test at any time. Remain in quarantine until test results are returned. If test comes back negative, student(s) may return to school but is required to wear a face covering for remainder of the ten (10) day quarantine. Please send a copy of the test results to school.

Option 2: Quarantine for ten (10) days from onset of symptoms.

Vaccination status/prior positive diagnosis: Individuals with a positive diagnosis within 90 days of exposure fall under the vaccinated designation.

Definitions:

- Close Contact: An individual is not wearing a face covering and who is within three(3) feet of a person (per CDC school guidelines) for 15 minutes or longer of a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Quarantine Timeline: Quarantine timeline begins ten (10) days from the onset of symptoms with release on 11th day.
