JOB TITLE: Skilled Plumber

Job Purpose Statement: The job of "Plumber" is done for the purpose of performing maintenance of the District's plumbing systems and components to provide comfort, sanitation and safety in facilities; identifying locations of existing plumbing and irrigation systems; providing information on proper operation of plumbing and irrigation systems; determining the efficient installation of additional systems; and ensuring availability of materials to complete assignments in a timely manner.

Essential Job Functions:

- * Analyzes drawings, schematics, and systems for the purpose of identifying existing plumbing and irrigation systems and determining the efficient installation of additional systems.
- * Diagnoses problems and/or failures in plumbing and irrigation systems for the purpose of identifying repair and replacement needs to maintain equipment and systems.
- * Installs plumbing and irrigation systems and fixtures for the purpose of providing comfort, sanitation and safety within facilities and maintenance of grounds.
- * Maintains tools and equipment for the purpose of providing availability and safe, operational condition necessary to ensure completion of work activity in a timely manner.
- * **Prepares** written documentation for the purpose of providing written support, accountability and conveying information.
- * **Procures** materials, supplies and/or equipment for repair work for the purpose of ensuring availability to complete assignments in timely manner.
- * **Repairs** plumbing and irrigation systems and components for the purpose of ensuring proper and safe operation of systems and fixtures.
- * **Responds** to emergency situations for the purpose of resolving immediate safety and operational concerns and preventing further damage to property.
- * Transports materials, tools, supplies and/or equipment for the purpose of providing items at job site as required to complete work activity.

Other Job Functions:

- * Assists other personnel as may be required for the purpose of supporting them in the completion of their work activities.
- * Attends training and/or classes for the purpose of maintaining skills and meeting credential requirements.
- * Coordinates/assists maintenance staff, other personnel and/or contractors for the purpose of completing projects and/or work orders efficiently.

* Skills, Knowledge and/or Abilities Required:

Skills to: operate and maintain tools and equipment relating to plumbing and irrigation systems; read and interpret plans, blueprints and/or schematics; perform algebra and geometry; perform specialized/technical tasks; administer appropriate assessment instruments and techniques; use English in both written and verbal form to communicate effectively with staff, contractors and/or the public; and plan and manage projects.

Knowledge of: methods and use of materials, tools and equipment used in plumbing trade; appropriate building codes, safety practices, systems components; and basic computer operations.

Abilities to: adhere to safe work practices; apply pertinent codes, policies, regulations and/or laws; understand and carry out oral and written instructions; adjust to flexible work assignments; work accurately with minimal supervision; work under time constraints; interact with persons of different age groups and cultural/educational backgrounds; work cooperatively with others; and meet deadlines and schedules.

Significant physical abilities include walking/standing for prolonged periods, lifting/ carrying/ pushing/pulling, climbing/balancing, stooping/kneeling/crouching, reaching/ handling/ fingering/feeling, talking/hearing conversations and other sounds, near/far visual acuity/ depth perception/visual accommodation, exposure to temperature changes/weather conditions; able to work in confined areas.
